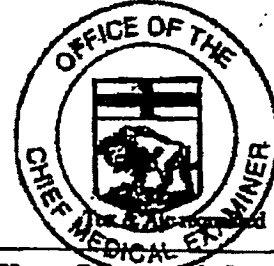

Case was found unresponsive by her father in the morning. Resuscitative efforts by a family member, Winnipeg Ambulance and Health Sciences Centre were unsuccessful. A rectal temperature of 40° was obtained at the Health Sciences Centre Emergency. The infant had been last seen about one hour prior to being found when she was changed and put to sleep on her back. The child had recently had a cold with a cough and nasal stuffiness. The father was in charge of the case and a 1 year old sibling as the mother had left the family about two weeks previously.

**Autopsy Findings**

- Chubby, well cared for appearing female infant with
  - 1.1 diaper dermatitis, early and moderate
  - 1.2 no congenital anomalies.
- No significant trauma.
  - 2.1 0.3 cm bruise, posterior right parietal scalp
  - 2.2 negative x-ray study
  - 2.3 normal brain and brain covering.
